1) Short-Term Scientific Mission grant (STSM, coord. S. Kefauver)

Visit a SENSECO host organization located in a different country than the one of your affiliation. A clear link to our MoU is required.

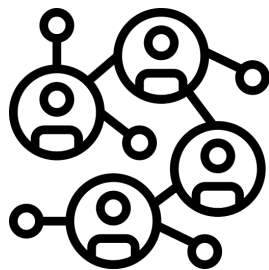
2) Virtual Mobility grant (VM, coord. V. Sobejano Paz)

Collaborate in a virtual setting with other researchers or innovators within the COST Action, to exchange knowledge, learn new techniques, etc ... within SENSECO objectives.

Who can apply?

Any researcher affiliated to a legal entity in:

- ✓ COST Full/Cooperating Member
- ✓ NNC
- ✓ European RTD



Grant amount

- 1) **STSM**: up to 2000 EUR
- 2) **VM**: up to 1500 EUR
- 3) **ITC CG**: up to **2000 EUR** per grant for face to face and up to **500 EUR** for virtual conferences

Presentations at external conferences

3) ITC Conference grant (ITC CG, coord. D. Ganeva) Young Researchers and Innovators in an ITC or NNC.

Present your own work (poster/oral presentation) in a conference to establish a strong network and increase your visibility in the research community. A clear link to our MoU is required.

Who can apply?

- ✓ Young Researchers and Innovators: <40 years
- ✓ Affiliated with a legal entity:
strictly ITC and NNC



When to apply?

Deadlines for applications are 1/3/2022 and 1/5/2022.
Funds are limited so early applications are encouraged.



Reporting and claim:

- 1) **STSM**: work developed, main achievements and planned future follow-up activities.
- 2) **VM**: work developed, main outcomes, achieved outputs and description of future follow-up collaborations.
- 3) **ITC CG**: outcome of the presentation, in terms of grantee visibility, establishment of new contacts for future collaboration, certificate of attendance, programme or book of abstracts/proceedings, copy of presentation or poster.
Submit the report **within 30 days after the end of the activities!**
